- See the statement on page 5 of the application between numbers 4 and 5 – If you do not have a letter confirming the care recipient’s diagnosis on a doctor’s letterhead, you may submit the application with a statement saying that the doctor’s letter will follow.
- Once submitted, you will be contacted and informed that they have begun the vetting process. The process is expected to take 4-6 weeks to finalize. Best wishes!
